Happy Thanksgiving!

Many of us know the origins of the Thanksgiving holiday as a time when the pilgrims sat down to share a meal with the Wampanoag tribe. Both the pilgrims and the Wampanoag people were giving thanks for the friendship that they shared and the opportunities to learn from one another.

However, many people don't realize that Thanksgiving didn't become a national holiday until President Abraham Lincoln declared it a holiday during the Civil War.

I find it interesting that during a time of war, a national holiday was declared for all of us to pause and give thanks. It reminds me of the verse from 1 Thessalonians, "Rejoice always, pray continually, *give thanks in all circumstances*; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus," verses 16-18.

I believe that President Lincoln, much like the Apostle Paul, was trying to remind us that even in times of trial, we can begin the healing process by taking a posture of thankfulness. This is an awesome practice for us in our daily lives, and one that if we practice regularly, could have a huge impact in our lives and on the world around us.

What if, rather than getting upset in traffic, we paused to give thanks for the vehicle that is getting us from one location to another. What if, rather than complaining about slow service in a restaurant, we paused to give thanks for the extra time that we are spending with our friends and family over that meal. What if, rather than coveting the latest and greatest ____ (fill in the blank), we paused to give thanks for all that we are already blessed with.

Living in a posture of thankfulness helps us to combat frustration and impatience, fight against unhappiness and disappointment, and experience contentment and gratitude. But in addition to the positive things that we personally benefit from when we are thankful, think about how that person next to you in traffic feels when they look over and see someone singing along happily to their favorite song; or the waitress who gets to see a family enjoying their time together rather than receiving complaints; or the by product of our contentment when we share from our abundance of blessing rather than storing up earthly treasures.

So, this thanksgiving, I pray that there is a wonderful time of family, fellowship, and food... but I also pray that we adopt a posture of thankfulness that lasts all year. I am glad that we have a day to be thankful, but shouldn't we be thankful every day? My favorite song right now is "Thank You Lord" by Chris Tomlin, and the line that I want to leave you with is this: "Blessings, on blessings, on blessings, on blessings if I still have breath in these lungs, and that's all I need to get down on my knees and be thankful for all that He's done."






RED BAG FOOD PROJECT **Family Holiday Meals**

PASTOR'S REPORT TO CHARGE CONFERENCE

November 14, 2021

Book of Discipline 2016—The Pastor shall give a report on the state of the church and an account of pastoral ministry as it relates to (¶ 340): providing support, guidance, and training to the lay membership in the church; ministering within the congregation and to the world; and administering the temporal affairs of the congregation. Include as a part of the report is a statement outlining the pastor's program of continuing education and spiritual growth for the past year and plans for the year to come (¶ 349).

Sedge Garden UMC continues to be a deeply committed Church to making disciples and embracing the call to worship and serving God. This year has proven to be unlike any that we have experienced before due to the crisis of the COVID-19 Pandemic and racial injustice. This year has forced us to grapple with the question: What is the Church? Better said, Who is the Church? We realized as a COVID-19 Leadership Team that we are in this for the long haul of overcoming COVID-19. We established our values and held to them for guiding our approach to reopening:

Mission – The Mission of Christ continues. We will worship God and we will join Christ on mission in our community and world.

Safety – Each person matters to God, and we will ensure safety for all who connect to Sedge Garden UMC.

Adaptability – The Church has adapted across cultures and over time to continue its mission. Our ministry has, is, and will continue to adapt to share the love of Christ.

Efforts in 2021 to be a church for our community and for the world:

We paid off our mortgage debt seven years early!!! We recorded services and music to enable worship to continue happening in homes.

We allowed those with no technology to have priority access to worshipping in person based upon current COVID-19 Leadership Team Decisions.

We designed special Holy Week Services to help us prepare for Easter Sunday as a Church through recording and premiering them online. This attracted great engagement.

We hosted an in-person outdoor Easter Egg Hunt for our community with over 4,000 eggs to be collected.

We hosted a joint outdoor Easter worship service led by both the band and chancel choirs where several joined the Church.

We reopened our Pre-School in a pilot method for the summer with an outdoor preschool to increase greater safety. 52 children participated.

We hosted an outdoor VBS for our community with numerous non-Sedge Gardeners in attendance.

We engaged in a Youth Mission Trip through Urban Ministry with Carolina Cross Connection working at Haywood Street Congregation in Asheville, NC.

We took two groups of youth hiking through the Wilderness Trail Backpack Ministry to strengthen their spiritual journey.

We have offered in-person and online Sunday School options for much of 2021 for families who do not feel ready to return in person.

We celebrated our mortgage payoff with a joint worship service.

We have collected several thousand pounds of food for Crisis Control toward our 6000-pound goal in 2021.

We have partnered together as ministries for greater impact through items such as:

The Pumpkin Patch – A fundraiser connecting us to new families in our community.

Stronger Combined Worship Services such as Easter Sunday, July 4th and Packathon Sunday.

The Fall Masquerade Bash partnership between Garden Kids, Grounded Youth Ministry, and Traditional Worship Ministry.

We packed 32,000 meals for Packathon with Feed the Hunger, bringing us to packing as a Church over 250,000 meals in nine years.

Our Fall Masquerade Bash Trunk or Treat had more community families than SGUMC families participating in the face painting, trunk or treat, cheesecake sale, and spooky organ concert and costume runway! We have hosted online and in-person concerts for our community.

We have visited over 80 families during our pastor pop-in parade times of staying connected with folks where we sing hymns, pray, and celebrate Holy Communion.

Even in the midst of a pandemic, Sedge Garden remains a vibrant called community where followers of Jesus worship, grow in their relationship with Christ and one another, and serve generously.

In the last year (2021), I have participated in the following continuing education opportunities:

Executive Leadership Coaching provided by High Performance Academy and Growth.com.

Continued Training with the Outward Mindset Coaching through WNCCUMC.

Read numerous books and professional journals related to ministry.

Completed two weeks of the Reynolds Academy of Leadership through the WNCCUMC Foundation. Attended future UMC meeting with young clergy and top 400 largest churches in the denomination at Church of the Resurrection, Leawood, KS.

Completed serving on the leadership team for the Transforming Community Cohort 16 with the Transforming Center, Naperville, IL.

My continuing education goals for the upcoming year (2022) include:

Complete my formation and spiritual growth leave focusing on the following:

Relationship with Christ – I am excited to have extended times of being with Christ in personal devotion. I can't wait to see how Christ meets me during these daily extended times.

Relationship with Family - I have said many times that the greatest impact of ministry anyone will ever have is with their family. I will be focused on nurturing relationships within my family and caring for Melissa as we walk through her journey of healing. She was diagnosed with an aneurysm behind her right eye in September, along with some other concerns related to her head. She is having to see several different specialists. I will also be focused on strengthening my relationship with Andrew and Esther and extended family.

Rest – I will be focused on care and nurturing myself to get the rest that God talks about in Psalm 23:1-2. Renewal – Each year in August I spend some time and read our *Book of Discipline* "Part III, Doctrinal Standards and our Theological Task as Methodists." It renews me each year as I spend time reflecting, especially on our theological task of reflecting upon God's gracious action in our lives, church, community, and world. I will be focused during my leave on reading John Wesley's sermons again and on Paul's letters to each of the churches that he connected with in his missionary journeys.

Complete the rest of Reynolds Leadership Academy.

Serve as a Page for next General Conference (2022 scheduled).

Begin working with a Mentor and Coach.

Become certified as a Wilderness First Responder for backpacking ministry trips.

Welcome the new supply pastors and a new church staff person.

Sedge Garden United Methodist Church welcomes **Rev. James (Jim) Martin** and **Rev. Dr. Quentin Scholtz** as the supply pastors during Pastor Justin Lowe's leave.
